Mat Cusack Awarded Senior Coach Qualification



On Thursday, 18 October, Mat Cusack, Head Coach at Kingsbridge Kingfisher Swim Club, was presented with his certificate by the swimmers and coaches at the club.

Mat was one of only 40 or so swim coaches selected this year across all swimming clubs in England to undertake the Senior Coach Level 3 Qualification training.

The training is a huge commitment involving 9 months of study and 3 residential weekends in Loughborough at the home of Swim England based on the University Campus.

In addition to the intensive workshops at Loughborough (and his own business and other commitments), Mat had to undertake many hours of study, course work and preparation of sessions that were observed by his mentor. This assessments took place at Quayside during Club sessions, Regional Competitions in Bristol and at the Life Centre in Plymouth.

Congratulations of course go to Mat and his family and everyone who has supported him over the past 9 months!

The club would also like to thank Mat's mentor Jo John from Exeter City Swimming club who has over 40 years' experience and coaching at the highest level.

KKSC Off To A Strong Start At Exeter Sprints!

This Level 3, Short Course competition at Plymouth Life Centre was the first meet of the new season and what a start! 30 swimmers took part in a possible 5 races including 50m in all strokes and the 100 Individual Medley.

There were some outstanding swims with 74 new personal best times gained and this year's swimmers stacked up an incredible 12 gold, 5 silver and 10 bronze medals. Our medal winners were:
