KKSC and BSLSC Make a Splash at 2018 Rotary Club Swimarathon



The annual Swimarathon, organised by the Rotary Club of Kingsbridge Estuary, took place on Friday 12th October 2018 at Quayside Leisure Centre.

Kingsbridge Kingfishers Swimming Club (KKSC) and Bantham Surf Life Saving Club (BSLSC) entered 80 enthusiastic swimmers, raising money in aid of the Primrose Foundation for breast cancer treatment at Derriford Hospital, and each respective club.

In total, the KKSC and BSLSC teams swam an incredible 1451 lengths, with the amount raised estimated at £1,500.

The Rotary Club team record of 234 lengths was set in 2014 by BSLSC and, as is now tradition, there is an annual 'friendly' swimoff between the two clubs, whilst they both attempt to break the record. This year the Bantham team 'TriOcean Sharks' managed a very respectable 195 lengths, and remain the triumphant record holders, but were denied victory on the day by the KKSC 5 team who swam an impressive 203 lengths.

Jo Lawrence, organiser of the BSLSC and KKSC teams said; "Huge thanks to all swimmers and sponsors, but especially to the Rotary Club team who work so hard every year to make this fantastic event such a resounding success".
