The first swimmer to dive into the pool with the ropes in place was new bronze squad member Ivy Thompson, while at the other end of the club, Lucas Quiggin credited the lane ropes and calm water for being able to complete a set of thirty-five 100m front crawls.

Many people must be thanked again for their help in putting the ropes into place. From the individuals and businesses who donated to our appeals back in August, to Anti-Wave for the swift delivery of the lane ropes and Dartmouth Swimming Club for the recommendation.

We must also thank the lifeguards at Quayside for trying to get to grips with them! It is the first time the ropes have been replaced since the club was first formed in 1998.

## City of Plymouth Champs: Relay fun and golds galore!

First ever gold medal for speedy Emilia

The annual City of Plymouth's offer the full complement of swimming events, from the 50 metre sprints to the more painful 1500m freestyle and 400m medley. Twelve swimmers took up the challenge to become city champions in this early season competition.

The event also has heats and finals for the 100m events. Aaron Lansdale was our only qualifier to one such final, coming a close 4th in a brilliant 100m freestyle race.

While Aaron went home without a gold on this occasion, there is no doubt he is helping to inspire the next generation. Chloe Morris won another bagful of golds, silvers and bronzes. Her strongest performance was arguably the 200m breaststroke, where she won with a time that was only 4 seconds off a regional qualifying time.

Chloe, along with Lucas Quiggin, have recently been promoted to gold squad as a result of their dedication. Lucas found PBs hard to come by as he recovered from a foot injury, but still won a bronze and achieved many county times. The two of them teamed up with the rapidly improving McKinlay siblings in the medley relay, a noisy event that was a great experience for all four swimmers.

In one of the last events of the meet, Emilia beat off tough competition to become the ten year old city champion for the 50m freestyle! It was her first ever medal, let alone a gold coloured one! Meanwhile Ollie shaved his 50m freestyle time down to just 34 seconds.

The next generation of Kingfishers also flourished over the first weekend. County times were achieved by Faye Morris and Danny Clack, who also took part in their first ever relays. Fabiano Noto won bronze in the 100m backstroke, while Bert Rogers made his debut at the Life Centre and was only 6 seconds off qualifying for the 200m backstroke, a superb effort thanks to his excellent endurance!

Our other inspirational club captain Jess Stewart swam a brilliant 200m backstroke to earn a PB. She also briefly led in the exciting cannon relay, where she was joined by Jack Sagar, Ethan Clack, Emilia, Chloe and Aaron.

The answer is to be brave and enter as many events as possible! This year, there are opportunities to swim in 200m backstroke, 200m breaststroke and even 200m butterfly! We also have a 400m freestyle, while Dartmouth swimming pool will host a girls' 800m freestyle and a boys' 1500m freestyle on Saturday December 2nd.

You may be the fastest in your age over 50 metres, but if you don't try to swim the longer events, you won't win as many points! As written by Karen in her email to parents, children often regret not entering more races. **So why not enter more!** It's perhaps understandable if your child doesn't fancy the 200m butterfly, or the long distance Dartmouth races, but you'll probably need to enter everything else to become club champion. Moreover, it only costs £5 to enter every race.

The £5 entry fee helps to hire the pool for our big Saturday night event on the 25th November.

Club Captain puts Kingsbridge on the map in the 1500 Freestyle

Sheffield's Ponds Forge pool was the venue for Jess Stewart as she competed at the Masters National Championships over the last weekend of October.

Supported by her dedicated parents, Jess began her quest for success with the 1500m freestyle event.

1500m Freestyle is equal to swimming 60 lengths at Quayside, so it's a pretty long race! However where there's distance involved, you'll probably find a Stewart in attendance. Jess has a fantastic attitude to training which helps fuel her longer distance racing. Coming home from the 1500m event with a silver medal is an excellent reward for her efforts.

The next day, Jess also competed in the slightly shorter 800m Freestyle event. That's 32 lengths at Quayside! She battled against tiredness to claim a 5th place finish. Everyone back in Kingsbridge is proud of her, make sure you say well done if you see her walking into training!







#### Want to follow in Jess' footsteps?

Silver squad members are encouraged to join extra training sessions on Tuesday evenings (6pm to 7pm) and Friday evenings (6:30pm to 8pm) where they can receive more technical advice about their swim technique while building their fitness for longer races.

Monday mornings (7am to 8am) are perfect for swimmers who go to school at KCC. Previous swimmers have not only benefited from the boost it gives them to their swimming, but also to their concentration at school.



Please talk to Karen if you wish to add an additional session for your child/children.

Some of these sessions can be fairly quiet, which means that your coaches can give more guidance and support to those who attend. There is no doubt that this will improve your racing!
